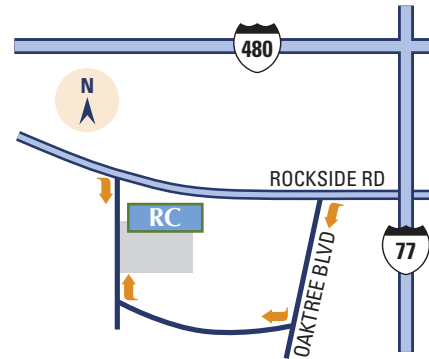

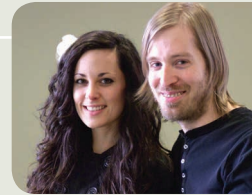
CATHERINE MONNIN
