Join us for Worship & Prayer Night this Friday, September 18, at 7pm, here in the sanctuary. This time is open to anyone, so feel free to invite friends and family!



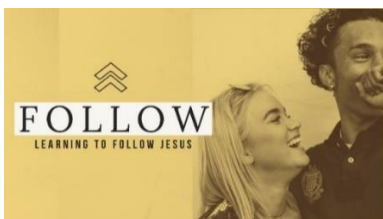
### MENS BREAKFAST
